Executive Summary

Executive Summary

- ❑ Global InfoAnalytics poll carried out in all the 18 constituencies in the Northern region shows Dr Mahamudu Bawumia, the flag bearer of the NPP, trailing the leading opposition NDC candidate, John Mahama 37% to 55%. Alan Kyeremanten of the Butterfly movement is in third place with 4%, others 1% and undecided 3%.
- ❑ The Economy remains top issue for voters, 78%, jobs, 70%, education, 61% and corruption, 21%.
- ❑ 58% voters in the Northern region believe Ghana is headed in the wrong direction, 34% said it is headed in the right direction and 8% did not have an opinion.
- ❑ On standard of living of voters in the last 12 months, 49% said it has gotten worse, 31% said it has improved, 16% said there has not been any change while 6% said they have no opinion. When it comes to optimism for improvement, 39% were optimistic their standard of living will improve in the next 12 months, 23% said no and 38% were not sure if it will improve.
- ❑ The poll also shows that 64% of voters believe that politics is one issue that mostly divide Ghanaians, 20% said it is religion while 16% said it is ethnicity.
- ❑ On the policies/slogans from the various campaign teams that have caught their attention and would likely influence how they vote in the 2024 elections, 49% said the 24 hrs economy, 37% digitisation, 4% said the Great Transformation Plan and 10 % said none.
- ❑ On the question of whether the NPP can break the eight, 57% said “No”, 36% said “Yes) and 7% did not have an opinion.



Methodology & Approach


Methodology and Approach:

- Sample size: 1,538 were interviewed with
- Confidence level: 99% and MoE of $\pm 3.19\%$
- Demographic analysis and constituency specific polls would have higher margin of error.
- The Electoral Commission's 2020 voters register was used as sample frame.
- Sample was allocated to all the 18 constituencies in the region based on voters register of the constituencies relative to the regional register
- The results are based on "likely voters" model (both registered and unregistered voters) and exclude responses of voters who have indicated that they will not vote.
- The general elections polls are presented unweighted
- Field interviews were conducted between 20th November to 30th November 2023.












Standard of living

How do you describe your standard of living in the last 12 months




Optimism for improvement in standard of living –Next 12 months








2024 Elections-Constituencies






2020 Results vs Northern Poll (Excl. undecided)


2020 Elections vs 2024 Voting Intentions



How likely would you change your mind about your voting intentions?







How Likely would the Religion of the Candidates Influence your vote?






